

Post-doctoral Positions

Paris School of Economics (PSE) is offering Post-Doctoral positions starting Sept 1, 2023 (flexible; in particular, an earlier date is possible). These positions can be for one or two years and come with no teaching nor administrative duties so that Post-Doctoral students can devote all of their time to their research.

These post-doctoral positions are offered as part of PSE's ambition to develop research at the frontier with other disciplines. In particular, we are looking for students working on urban studies, with a strong background in a field different from economics, e.g. sociology, geography, or history, yet focusing on topics that relate to economics.

Potential applicants may want to look at the webpage dedicated to the <u>Urban Economics</u>, <u>History and Society project</u> along with the presentation of the wider initiative "<u>opening</u> <u>economics</u>" developed at PSE.

Successful applicants will be expected to interact and work with economists at PSE, and must therefore have shown their ability to engage in a fruitful dialogue with economists.

They will be provided with office space and computer facilities as well as a research budget. Salary, competitive in Europe, will depend on experience. The PhD should be completed or duly planned by the date of the appointment. Applicants with a Ph.D. obtained prior to 2019 will not be considered. Knowledge of French is NOT required.

The application package should include a sample of the applicant's research (e.g. a job market paper, or any relevant working paper) along with a CV and a motivation letter including references we may contact.
